The TRE begins in Rapid City and flows through the cities of Spearfish, Belle Fourche, Bowman, Belfield, Watford City, Williston, Culbertson, Plentywood, and finally through the Port of Raymond into Canada.

To Whom It May Concern:

The Theodore Roosevelt Expressway Association is asking for your support through membership to assist in the promoting and marketing of the Theodore Roosevelt Expressway trade and travel corridor.

The Association is currently in the process of working on a partnership agreement with the Department of Transportation to complete the first phase of the Corridor Management Plan in North Dakota.

Montana along US 2/MT, has completed a study known as the Transportation Regional Economic Development (TRED). This study has led to the next step, an Environmental Assessment. The EA is being completed for a portion of the US 2 Corridor from the North Dakota State line, to Bainville, Montana proceeding on to Culbertson, Montana. South Dakota has a divided highway from Rapid City to Belle Fourche and in the future a Corridor Management Plan could help plan the Corridor north of Belle Fourche to the North Dakota State line.

This is an important first step in the completion of a plan that would move the corridor towards the necessary improvements of the highway to include: passing lanes, widening of the shoulders and turning lanes to improve the efficiency and safety of the highway.
